



MOTOTOUR OF NATIONS 2015 RULES

<u>Rule. 1</u>

Commissione Turistica

The Mototour of Nations 2015 is being organised by: Italian Motorcycling Federation (FMI).

The event, organised under the auspices of the International Motorcycling Federation (FIM) and the Touring and Leisure Commission (CTL), will be staged from 10/09/2015 to 13/09/2015 in accordance with the FIM Tourist Gatherings Code (hereafter referred to as CTC).

Rule 1.2 Executive Committee

The first meeting of the Executive Committee will be held on 10/09/2015 at the Event headquarters at 5 p.m. Subsequent meetings will be fixed by the Executive Committee.

Rule 2 Participation in the Mototour of Nations

The number of participants will be limited to 200. 90% of participants must be non-Italian motorcyclists, with a view to promoting the Liguria and Piemonte regions internationally. Entries will be accepted from February 2015 to June 2015. The main focus of travel along the chosen itineraries will be that of ensuring participants' safety. Participants will be split up into groups of thirty bikes, accompanied by an escort rider, at a steady "tourist" speed, with frequent stop-offs as per the programme. Also travelling behind participants will be vans for carrying luggage, trailers for equipment, a bus for transporting any other passengers and an ambulance. Major junctions will be manned, and selected roadways will be fully tarmacked and suitable for motorcycling in any weather. Over the two days the total distance travelled will be around 500 km.

Rule 3 Entries

Entries must be sent by no later than 30 June 2015, with payment into the FMI current account of the full amount and sending of the entry form, which will be published on the website http://www.fim-mototour2015.it/ – together with the final programme.

- a) Individual entries will be processed using the form issued by the FMN organising the event and sent by National Federations see **Rule 1.1**;
- **b)** National Federations must submit a summary document (in excel) giving the following information:
 - 1) Names of participants;
 - 2) Amounts paid for registration;
 - 3) Distance of Moto Club from the Event centre;
 - 4) Name, Licence number and email address of national delegates.
- c) The entry fee is fixed by the participant's Federation. It includes the price set by the organiser $(\notin 250.00 \text{supplement for single room} = \notin 90.00)$ plus commission for administrative costs that may be added by the FMN. The amount is in euro (\notin) .
- **d)** Children aged between 8 and 12 years old will pay 50% of the entry fee, while children up to the age of 7 will not be charged.
- e) The entry fee must be paid in full (100%) by the FMN of participants by 30/06/2015 into the following current account:

All payments must be made in Euro (€), and must cover the travel allowance.

Rule 5 Final entry date

The entry deadline is 30 June 2015.

Rule 6 Services provided to participants

All participants that have paid entry fees will be entitled to:

- > 3 nights in a hotel ***/**** or similar structure, twin/double room, or single room with supplement (€90.00), breakfast;
- ➤ 1 welcome dinner in the hotel (Thursday 10 September) in Sanremo, including drinks;
- > 1 dinner (Friday 11 September) in Cuneo, including drinks;
- ▶ 1 gala dinner (Saturday 12 September) in the hotel, including drinks;
- ➢ 2 lunches along the route (Friday 11 and Saturday 12)
- Visits and trips, with food tasting, to Monaco and Cuneo;
- Event souvenir; Mototour medal and sticker;
- Road and healthcare assistance throughout the event; transportation of baggage during the tour.

Rule 7 Accommodation

Hotel reservations are included in the entry fee, and must be paid before 30/06/2015 into the bank account given in Rule 3/e.

All payments must be made in Euro (€), and must cover the travel allowance.

Rule 8 Meeting point

The reception centre will be open on 10 September from 11:00 to 19:00

On the day of arrival each participant will receive information on the Event programme. Entry forms and participants' vehicles will be checked at the reception centre. Participants will receive a pass once registered.

All bikers will be given an "itinerary sheet" with a road map of the two itineraries, showing the number of kilometres travelled along the routes and space for "checkpoint" stamps which will be affixed at the rest areas and finishing lines of each leg.

Rule 9 Results and rankings

The following prizes will be awarded:

- 1. National Federation;
- **2.** Club;
- 3. Age of participant.

In detail, ranking rules are:

- a) Each rider acquires 1 point per km travelled from one's own club, plus 1 point per km travelled on the two legs.
- **b)** At the end of the second leg each rider will hand in his "itinerary sheet" for checking the required "checkpoint" stamps; if any one of the stamps is missing the score will not be assigned to the National Federation or Club. After it is checked, the "itinerary sheet" will be handed back to the rider.
- c) The "National Federation" ranking is calculated as the sum of scores obtained by single riders belonging to the National Federation.
- d) The "Club" ranking is calculated as the sum of scores obtained by single riders belonging to the same national club.

The results will be displayed two hours before the prize giving ceremony, at the place of gala dinner on 12th of September. Executive Committee will be available to National Delegates to deal with any objections to results, up to 30 minutes prior to the final prize-giving ceremony.

Rule 10 Prizes

National Federation Classification: the FIM/Mototour of Nations Trophy (made available by the Organising Federation) will be given to the winning Federation; second and third ranked Federations will receive a cup;

National Club Classification: the "Piemonte Region" Trophy will be given to the winning Club; second and third ranked Clubs will receive a cup;

Age classification: The three youngest riders will be given "FMI Italia" cups.

Rule 11 Disqualification

At its sole discretion, the Executive Committee is empowered to officially disqualify participants should this be necessary.

Rule 12 Prize-giving ceremony

The prize-giving ceremony will take place on the evening of 12 September 2015.

Rule 13 National Delegates

Each participating nation is entitled to appoint a delegate with respective licence number. Details of the delegate must be communicated at least 15 days prior to the start of the event. See also **Rule 3/b/4**.

Rule 14 Cancellation of Event

The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event in the event of:

• *force majeure*

If the Event is cancelled, participants that have entered the Event within the set deadline will be informed of the cancellation and will be duly reimbursed.

<u>Rule 15 Cancellation of individual entry</u>

The possible cancellation of an entry or replacement of the individual must be done through the participant's Federation and sent to the organisers by no later than 31 July 2015.

Rule 16 Liability of authorities, organisers and participants

Refer to CTG, art. 19 (Class A tourist gatherings).

Rule 17 Conduct of motorcyclists and protection of the environment

Mototour of Nations participants are ambassadors of their nations, and must show respect for other road users (CTC Rally art.3).

Recommendations for road users:

Article 11.2 of FIM Environmental Code - Rider conduct

- a) individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users;
- a) ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding;
- **b**) save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines;
- c) ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency;
- d) noise annoyance. Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level;
- e) use only routes which are open to motorcyclists;
- f) ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups;
- **g**) respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery;
- h) protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently;
- i) ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled;
- **j**) encourage a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles;
- **k)** remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits.
